



## Performance Horse Awards Rules - 2017

*The 2017 AHS Performance Horse Awards are kindly sponsored by  
Gadebrook Performance Arabians*

This free year-long ridden competition for AHS members' horses is in three categories:-

Pure Bred Arabs

Anglo Arabs

Part Arabs

There is also a Junior winner (split into Pure Bred Arabians, Anglo Arabs and Part Bred Arabs if numbers warrant).

The competition is open to AHS- registered Mares, Stallions and Geldings aged 4 years and over which are in the registered ownership of a current AHS member (or leased to a current AHS member). The rider does not need to be an AHS member.

Perpetual Challenge Trophies and individually-named rosettes will be presented to the owners of winning horses by the AHS President during the 2018 National Arab Show .

The **Dinsdale Memorial Trophy** is presented to the Champion Pure Arab;  
the **Westpoint Trophy** to the Champion part-Arab;  
the **Lady Yule Memorial Trophy** to the Champion Anglo-Arab; and  
the **Farenza Cup** to the leading Junior Rider (under 18 on 1 January 2017).

Results will be announced in January 2018 and at the AGM of the AHS in April 2018.

Please return your completed card before the 30 November 2017 to The Arab Horse Society, Agriculture House, Charnham Lane, Hungerford RG17 0EY.

Cards received after this date cannot be included in the competition.

### Conditions and Rules

1. The competition runs between 1<sup>st</sup> January and 30 November 2017
2. Horse owners must be members of the Arab Horse Society; copy of horse's registration certificate to accompany Points Card on completion
3. PHA Points Cards are available free for members from The Arab Horse Society or by e-mail: [pha@gadebrookstud.com](mailto:pha@gadebrookstud.com)
4. Entries are to be recorded on the official Points Card, and must be signed on the day of competition by the judge or Show Secretary or similar official.
5. Competitors count their best 20 placings, indicated with a ✓ in the final column of the card
6. Competitors must have gained a minimum of 100 points (except Junior entrants) including bonus points
7. Part Bred Arab entries must have not less than 12.5% pure Arabian blood.
8. For individual discipline High Points Awards, results must come from affiliated competition.
9. Should an entered horse change ownership during the calendar year of the competition, the points gained shall be carried forward for the benefit of the new owner. The owner at the

30 November shall receive any award achieved. If the new owner is an AHS member, points gained after purchase may be amalgamated.

**Rules for Awarding Points**

1. Decisions made by the Arab Horse Society are final.
2. The following events are not eligible:- Prix Caprilli, Gymkhana and Pair and Team events.
3. Unless indicated otherwise on the Scoring sheet, events restricted to a particular group or branch of a society or organisation shall be scored at half points e.g. Riding Club “Members Only” days, Pony Club etc.
