Arab Horse Society Bursary Scheme

The purpose of this Fund is for the encouragement and promotion of the Ridden Arabian.

Information about the Bursary Scheme:

- There are three bursaries of £250 each available.

You must be an AHS member to be eligible to apply for the bursaries, competing with a horse registered in either of the AHS Stud Books or the Part Bred Register.

- The bursaries will be paid to assist with training costs, specific challenges, or competitions.

If a bursary has not been used within 12 months of the offer of the bursary the offer will be withdrawn. The financial prize will be paid by The Arab Horse Society following a receipt for the funding which can include training, education, equipment or any other cost approved by the Committee.

Extensions may be agreed in exceptional circumstances (e.g. injury or a specific training opportunity).

Selection Process:

Selection is based on an application, in which candidates should detail their experience and their aspirations and plans. This form must be submitted by email to treasurer@arabhorsesociety.org no later than 30th April 2017.

Application forms must be submitted electronically as they will be distributed to the Committee by email.

All application forms will be considered by the shows and events Committee of the AHS.

The forms will be evaluated against the potential positive exposure of the Arabian. The committee will base their decision on the contents of the nomination statements.

All bursaries will be awarded at the sole discretion of the Committee on behalf of the Arab Horse Society.

Any application made for bursaries may be rejected for any reason whatsoever and any decision made by the Committee will be final.

AHS Employees, Council and Committee Members and their immediate families will not be eligible.

There is no charge to submit entries for the bursary

Nominations are open to all UK residents - there is no age limit

Applicants should include photographs with copyright which they agree to make available for publication by the AHS – irrespective of whether they are successful or not.

Presentations will be made at the Arab Horse Society National Show and recipients should make themselves available if requested.

Winner to provide future short progress reports to update the Arab Horse Society on activity – include timescale

The successful winner will recognise that the intention of the Bursary is to enhance an individual's skills and help development of the Arabian profile.

All applicants will be informed by the 31st May 2017 whether they have been successful or otherwise.
