

## **THE AHS TRAINING PROCEDURES OF DISCIPLINARY COMMITTEE MEMBERS FOR THE NATIONAL LIST**

The Committee reserves the right to vary this procedure in exceptional circumstances

### **Attend any number of Stage 1 Classroom Courses**

These are educational events and are open to members and non-members. Those who would like to have an insight into the work of DC's are welcome to attend the classroom sessions as well as members who would like to continue with the whole course with a view to being considered for joining the List. Dates and venues will be advertised.

Instruction and discussions are led by experienced DC's and candidates undertake a written test.

Failure at three Classroom Courses or failure to respond to an invitation for further training results in the candidate's name being removed from the trainee list. Any further interest would have to start again at Stage 1.

Successful candidates showing clear ability as potential Disciplinary Committee Members will be invited to probation with at least two senior DC's from the approved list. The probationer will be tested on practical knowledge, on rules and on procedures whilst assisting the senior DC with duties.

These appointments must be arranged by the Training Co-ordinator.

If all probation reports are satisfactory candidates are recommended to AHS Shows and Events Committee for consideration of appointment to the AHS List of Disciplinary Committee Members.
