BRITISH ARABIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS
JUDGING PROCEDURE FOR BAC OPEN RIDDEN CLASSES

These classes may be split depending on numbers entered.

Classes are judged in three stages. At each stage exhibits gain marks which are then combined to give the final score.

At the first stage exhibits are assessed under saddle and ridden by the judge as in a normal ridden class. Each exhibit is awarded a mark out of 40.

During the class horses will be presented before the conformation judge for assessment of type and conformation.

Each exhibit is awarded a mark out of 20 and receives a commemorative rosette.

The top five horses with the highest combined ride and conformation marks are announced in catalogue order and go forward to the final stage.

At the third stage the top five finalists will remain in the arena for the final judging.

Each exhibit is required to give an individual show for which they will be awarded a mark out of 20. This mark will be combined with the marks from the earlier two stages, to give the final score and placing.

1st & 2nd prize winners from the Open Ridden BAC classes will go forward to the Open Ridden BAC Championship following the completion of the BAC section.

ECAHO AMATEUR CLASSES (Classes 11,12,13,) ARE CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ECAHO BLUE BOOK 2019. Available www.ecaho.org

Conditions of Entry:

Open to horses registered in any WAHO recognised stud book by the closing date of entries.

Entry Restrictions:

- a) Title Show, A Show, B Show or C International Show Gold, Silver and Bronze winners are not allowed to take part in an Amateur Show for the rest of that calendar year and two calendar years following, unless the horse has passed from a yearling to junior, from junior to a senior category. Geldings that have won Champion Gold or Silver medals at a Title Show or an A show cannot be shown at Amateur shows/classes for the rest of that calendar year and one calendar year following.
 - b) The Handler of the horse must not have been paid for showing, training or producing any horse for a third party. This includes any remuneration either as employment, casual showing, or any in-kind benefits whatsoever.
 - c) Horse not to have resided on a professional yard on show or training livery in the current year.
 - d) Horse not to have been shown by a professional handler in the current year. e) Horse not to have received regular training from a professional in the current year.
- Overqualified horses or handlers taking part in a class will be disqualified and liable to pay a fine of €300

Competitors in all other classes at The British Arabian Championships agree to be bound by the Arab Horse Society rules for showing 2019.

BRITISH ARABIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS QUALIFICATION INFORMATION

It is only necessary to qualify ONCE for the show, irrespective of which classes in which you wish to compete.

There are TWO methods of qualification

a) Standard prepaid card. Purchase a card in advance (£15) for a specific horse and take this card into the ring. The highest placed in the top 6 has the card signed by the judge.

b) Gold Card. The top 2 places in any AHS affiliated class throughout the show season (up to 31st August) will be given a GOLD Card. Re- turn this within 10 days with £15 or before August 20th with £30.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO FULLY COMPLETE YOUR CARDS BEFORE RETURNING .

They will not be accepted without the name of the horse, details of the show and correct payment.

All competitors at The British Arabian Championships agree to be bound by the Arab Horse Society Rules for Showing 2019, copies of which may be obtained by sending a self addressed and stamped envelope to the secretary. All ridden exhibits must be 4 years old and over.

HORSE OF THE YEAR SHOW QUALIFIER

SIMON CONSTABLE EQUINE VETS AND MR & MRS ROBERTS PURE BRED RIDDEN ARABIAN CLASSES 16, 17 & 18

The qualifying horse will be the highest placed exhibit within the first five in the ridden Arab classes which have been granted Horse of the Year Show qualifying status.

AHS Q Cards cost £35 per horse per season and must be purchased at least one week before the date of the class in which the horse will compete. Proceeds will be used for sponsorship at Horse of the Year Show. AHS Q Cards are available from The Arab Horse Society, Agriculture House, Charnham Lane, Hungerford RG17 0EY. Please make cheques payable to 'Arab Horse Society'. All queries should be directed to the AHS Shows Office Telephone 01672 521411

Results will be checked and any horse found not to have been issued with an AHS Q Card within the specified time will be deemed not to have qualified. Qualification will then pass down to the next eligible horse within the first five. There will be no opportunity to retrospectively pay the fees

SIMON CONSTABLE EQUINE VETS AND MR & MRS ROBERTS RIDDEN PUREBRED ARAB OF THE YEAR

This competition is for Ridden Purebred Arabians. Owners of qualified horses must be members of the Arab Horse Society and the horse registered in their owner's name. The exhibitor must have purchased an AHS Q card displaying the name of the horse.

This class will be divided into three sections as follows:

Section A Ridden Purebred Arab Gelding Section B Ridden Purebred Arab Stallion Section C Ridden Purebred Arab Mare

These classes will be run in accordance with the general rules as set out in the Horse of the Year Show rulebook, a copy of which can be downloaded from www.hoys.co.uk.

This is a Horse of the Year Show Qualifier, all data given upon entry of this class is provided to Grandstand Media Limited and stored on the Grandstand Entries System. For full policy details please visit www.grandstandentries.com.

This class is a qualifying class for Horse of the Year Show, NEC, Birmingham, 3rd - 7th October 2018. Qualification will not pass below 6th place. Qualification will be verified by the Horse of the Year Show office
