QUALIFICATION INFORMATION

It is only necessary to qualify ONCE for the show, irrespective of which classes in which you wish to compete.

There are TWO methods of qualification

- a) Standard prepaid card. Purchase a card in advance (£15) for a specific horse and take this card into the ring. The highest placed in the top 6 has the card signed by the judge.
- b) Gold Card . The top 2 places in any AHS affiliated class throughout the show season (up to 31st August) will be given a GOLD Card. Return this within 10 days with £15 or before August 20th with £30.

PLEASE REMEMBER TO FULLY COMPLETE YOUR CARDS BEFORE RETURNING . They will not be accepted without the name of the horse, details of the show and correct payment.

With the exception of classes 15-19, 25 and 26 all competitors at The British Arabian Championships agree to be bound by the Arab Horse Society Rules for Showing 2018, copies of which may be obtained by sending a self addressed and stamped envelope to the secretary. All ridden exhibits must be 4 years old and over.

WORKING IN

Working in will be available in the Main Indoor Arena from 7.30am until 8.25am on both days.

On Sunday, once the Outdoor Arena is also in use, a 10 minute warm up will be allowed in the arena prior to each ridden class.

This is not a championship class and will not receive prize money.

Gold, Silver and Bronze rosettes will be awarded and all participants will receive a special commemorative rosette.

THREE GENERATION BRITISH BRED

In each class the following special additional awards will be presented and exhibitors are asked to indicate on the entry form those for which they are eligible.

A sash for the highest placed Amateur Home Produced horse.

An award for the highest placed horse owned by its breeder.

A rosette for the highest placed Three Generations British Bred horse.

Exhibits receiving these awards in their class come forward for the respective Championships and trophies.

EVENING PERFORMANCES

The finals and championships are expected to continue until around 9pm.

Prize money will be withheld for any exhibit not appearing for its relevant championships.

Stabling has been arranged at a very reasonable £60 for the whole weekend until Monday morning. Exhibitors are able to take advantage of this special price to stay over the weekend and enjoy the evenings.

BRITISH ARABIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS

JUDGING PROCEDURE FOR RIDDEN CLASSES 1-3 AND 25-29

These classes may be split depending on numbers entered.

Classes are judged in three stages. At each stage exhibits gain marks which are then combined to give the final score.

At the first stage exhibits are assessed under saddle and ridden by the judge as in a normal ridden class. Each exhibit is awarded a mark out of 40. Marks are not announced and exhibits are not placed.

At the second stage the class returns immediately to the arena for assessment of type and conformation. No change of bridle is allowed but a change of handler is permitted.

Each exhibit is awarded a mark out of 20 and receives a commemorative rosette.

The top eight horses with the highest combined ride and conformation marks are announced in catalogue order and go forward to the final stage.

Exhibitors (apart from the top eight) are able to view their marks after the completion of all ridden classes in the section.

EVENING FINALE for the TOP EIGHT FINALISTS

At the third stage the top eight finalists return in the evening for the final judging.

They exhibit in afternoon wear and each is required to give an individual show for which they will be awarded a mark out of 20. This mark will be combined with the marks from the earlier two stages, to give the final score and placing.

Early in the calendar year, usually March, the AHS will publish 9 set shows (N1-3 R4-6 & O7-9) The set show chosen will be announced 7 days prior to the show.

These classes will be judged by 2 judges, one assessing the go round and the set show and the second assessing type and conformation. The Judge will not ride.

Marks will be awarded as follows

10 Marks - Go round (horses will be placed in a preliminary order and marks awarded 1st 10 points 2nd 9 points and so forth)

30 Marks - Show accuracy (5 marks for each of 6 set elements within the show)

10 Marks - Manners and style

20 Marks - Type

20 Marks - Conformation

10 Marks - Movement

BRITISH ARABIAN CHAMPIONSHIPS

ECAHO AMATEUR CLASSES (Classes 15-19) ARE CONDUCTED IN ACCORDANCE WITH THE ECAHO BLUE BOOK 2018. Available www.ecaho.org

Conditions of Entry:

Open to horses registered in any WAHO recognised stud book by the closing date of entries.

Entry Restrictions:

- a) Title Show, A Show, B Show or C International Show Gold, Silver and Bronze winners are not allowed to take part in an Amateur Show for the rest of that calendar year and two calendar years following, unless the horse has passed from a yearling to junior, from junior to a senior category. Geldings that have won Champion Gold or Silver medals at a Title Show or an A show cannot be shown at Amateur shows/classes for the rest of that calendar year and one calendar year following.
- b) The Handler of the horse must not have been paid for showing, training or producing any horse for a third party. This includes any remuneration either as employment, casual showing, or any in-kind benefits whatsoever.
- c) Horse not to have resided on a professional yard on show or training livery in the current year.
- d) Horse not to have been shown by a professional handler in the current year.
- e) Horse not to have received regular training from a professional in the current year.

Overqualified horses or handlers taking part in a class will be disqualified and liable to pay a fine of €300.

Competitors in all other classes at The British Arabian Championships agree to be bound by the Arab Horse Society rules for showing 2018. If you require a copy of the rules, please send a stamped addressed envelope to the secretary.
