RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Aljassimya Farm Online Show is a new concept of Arabian Horse Show that for the first time ever will be entirely held online. This digital event is exclusively supported by Aljassimya Farm as a way of reviving the Arabian Horse business in such difficult times and all joint sponsors are donating money directly to charity. It is the first ever TV format to include a presenter, judges and horse contenders presented through pre-recorded videos. The European edition will be split into: one dedicated to horses currently in Belgium and Netherlands taking place from May 8 to 10; one dedicated to horses currently in Uk, Austria, Czech Republic, Denmark, Germany, Poland, Romania, Russia, Scandinavia, Switzerland taking place from May 15 to 17 and one dedicated to Italy, France, Greece, Portugal and Spain from May 29 to 31.

People will be able to follow the show on the AJF and AI Social Media Channels as well as on the AJF website www.aljassimyafarm.com/onlineshow/. Farms and Training Centers are all invited to participate in the show and by sending the Entry Form agree to comply with the Video Regulations Documents and the rules explained below.

The following rules will be applied in their entirety.

By participating at the AJF Online Show, show organizers, judges, owners and handlers agree that they will unconditionally submit themselves and the persons assisting them to the rules provided in this Document.

SHOW ORGANIZER

- Combination of a class with the next age group of the same sex is permitted if the number of entries for the class is below three.
- The show organiser reserves the right to not put an entry in front of the judges if the Video Regulations have not been followed carefully enough and in their opinion the horse cannot be judged.
- Members of the Organizing Committee may not enter their own horses in the Show.
- The Organising Committee reserve the right to alter the conditions and timings of the show if circumstances require it
- The decision of the Organising Committee is Final.
- The show organizer will issue an online show catalogue. The name of every horse must be included in the show catalogue, as well as the names of sire and dam, (and maternal grandsire), date of birth, colour, the names of the breeder and owner and handler
- The show catalogue shall furthermore contain:
 - The names of all the judges
 - The Online Show Rules
 - The judging system used, the rules for ties and the rules for championships



JUDGES

- The judges invited for the show agree to act with integrity and honesty and to carry out their duties with the welfare of the horses in mind.
- Four judges will be invited and judge on rotation.
- Judges are requested to stick to the ECAHO regulations.
- The scoring system is the following:
 - the Classic European five topics system scoring system will be used in the Classes, but the scores will be awarded sequentially in the reverse order, to better fit the constraints of remote, live judging (i.e. Movement, Legs, Body & Topline, Neck, Head, Type).
 - Scoring will be from 20 with half points.
 - Head and Neck will be judged separately and an average taken which counts towards the total of 100.
 - The Comparative scoring system will be used in the Championship.
 - The Championship will follow the ECAHO Open Championship Rules.
- The scores will be given live and sequentially while watching the videos. The score can be given only once and it is not possible to go back and change the scores already given.
- Judges are requested to sign the Image Release Form.
- Judges agree not to consult the show catalogue before or during the show at which they are judging.
- Conflict of interest. Exhibitors must flag up known conflicts of interest with the judges when the entries are made/ judges are announced.
- An actual or apparent conflict of interest is when the horse:
 - has been bought or sold by a judge either as owner or agent
 - has been bred or is owned in whole or part by the judge or by a member of the official's family, or business partner in an Arab horse business venture
 - has been leased by the judge, at any time
 - has been bred by or is the property of a breeding organization in which the judge is or was an employee
 - has been regularly trained, examined or treated by the judge in a professional capacity
 - is the subject of an on-going negotiation to buy or lease, or a provisional purchase condition to which the judge is a party.



HANDLERS

- Handlers will be tidily dressed. Handlers will not wear clothes carrying any form of advertising which discloses the connection of the horse they are handling.
- The horse in the video must be shown standing, walking and trotting.
- The show will be held entirely ONLINE. To participate, it is necessary to make videos respecting the guidelines provided in the Video Regulations Document.
- Scoring System:
 - the Classic European five topics system scoring system will be used in the Classes, but the scores will be awarded sequentially in the reverse order, to better fit the constraints of remote, live judging. (i.e. Movement, Legs, Body & Topline, Neck, Head, Type).
 - Scoring will be from 20 with half points.
 - Head and Neck will be judged separately and an average taken which counts towards the total of 100.
 - The Comparative scoring system will be used in the Championship.
 - An Open championship will take place. The Gold, Silver and Bronze medal winners will be selected from amongst all the horses which have qualified in their respective classes for each championship.
 - The number of horses qualified from each class will be officially announced by the show organizer in the catalogue.
 - Each judge will nominate his choice for Gold, Silver and Bronze medals together at the same time, from all the horses qualified for the championship.
 - Points will be given to the nominated horses as follows:
 - A horse nominated by a judge for Gold Medal will receive 4 points.
 - A horse nominated by a judge for Silver Medal will receive 2 points.
 - A horse nominated by a judge for Bronze Medal will receive 1 point.
 - The Gold Medal will be awarded to the horse with the most votes for Gold Medal Champion. In case of an equal amount of vote for Gold Medal Champion, the Gold Medal will be awarded to the horse with the highest number of championships points.
 - From the remaining horses:
 - The Silver Medal will be awarded to the horse with the highest number of championship points.



- The Bronze Medal will be awarded to the horse with the 2nd highest number of championship points.
- Handlers are to make themselves available to make a video call or a video in case they win.
- The handler should comply with the rules provided here below:
 - No alteration of the basic color of the skin, coat or hooves is permitted. Hoof paints, colorless varnishes, coat dyes, glitter spray and cosmetic operations including skin grafts are forbidden. Tail and mane hair extensions are forbidden. Colorless hoof oils, Vaseline or oil and white chalk used on white legs will be accepted.
 - Artificial methods of dilating the eyes or affecting the natural action of the horse or otherwise influencing its action or behavior by oxygenating the bloodstream or by the use of weights or artificially weighted shoes, or by electrical or chemical treatment of any kind at any time before or during exhibition are forbidden. Burns, cuts or other marks on the body of any exhibit in such places or positions as to indicate that prohibited methods have been used will be regarded as full and adequate grounds for exclusion of any exhibit from competition.
 - Excessive whipping, excessive stimulation by noise, excessive circling of the horse, intimidation, use of electric shock devices and infliction of pain by any means, gingering are forbidden at all times. Abusive shanking is not permitted.

We invite you all to keep in mind that this is a Charity Event and we are sure that - besides the rules - everybody will Play Fair and have the Good Cause in mind.
