

## The UK Arabian In Hand Awards

A points-earning, year-long competition for members who wish to show in non-ECAHO classes and to encourage them to undertake more shows with their registered horses, in order to:

1. Encourage more people into the breed through exposure to the breed at shows where there may not be a natural interest in Pure/PB/Anglo/High Percentage Arabian horses.
2. To offer recognition to those who show their horses to a wide audience and achieve good results therefore acting as good ambassadors for the breed.
3. Encourage new owners to get involved in showing
4. Offer a competition to the newly created High Percentage Part Bred category

### Rules of the Award Scheme

1. Timeframe from 1 June to 31<sup>st</sup> May
2. Participants must be AHS members
3. All horses must be AHS registered
4. Three categories –  
Pure Bred Arabians,  
Part Bred/Anglo Arabians  
High Percentage Part Bred Arabians  
Silver and Bronze Championships to be awarded for each category at the National Show
5. Award points card issued at beginning of competing year where all results must be marked  
1 card per horse not per owner
6. Top 15 placings count towards scheme and must be logged on award card, the card must be signed by the Judge in the ring
7. In the case of transfer of ownership the award card can be given to new owner to continue with the scheme for that year
8. In the case of a tie on points the horse to have won more points from awarded Championships will prevail
9. Points awarded as follows:

Points from ECAHO affiliated classes are not permitted
